Special Order: Budget discussion with Office Mgr. Jack Dudek: \$900,000 projected revenue fromassessments. 2024 Revenue was \$1,077,000. \$116,000 of that was asphalt project fee.2024Expenses were \$1,060,263. Asphalt project expenses were \$109,000 resulting in \$7000 still available forforfuture asphalt projects.Payroll breakdown from 1/1/24 – 10/31/24.

Unfinished (Old) Business

Allocation of \$5000 for installation of heating equipment to front bathhouse was approved. Odani HVAC put in a split system for \$2400. Volunteers helped drill holes needed for installation. This all resulted in a \$2600 savings.

Debts of truck and tractor: Less than 6 months for payoff of both loans.

New Business:

Bloomsdale Excavation being considered to provide a driver to grade our roads on as as needed basis (projecting 2-4 days a month). Cost of using their trained equipment driver is \$93.45/hr. We want to provide a trial opportunity to see if it is a worthy endeavor. This will occur next week if a driver is available. **All in favor of cost and trial.**

Rock will be placed on the roads as needed with a hauling contractor providing 8 hours of rock hauling per day when the grader is in operation. **All in favor.**

Computer system needs: Guard Shack equipment needs new drivers.

Office needs new software and all need IT support. Our present IT person is 80 and ready to give it up.

Angle Gate: has been out of operation for nearly a month. Property Owners concerned over lack of information and action to fix the problem.

Request to use Sugar Shack from Devron Bridges for Free Thanksgiving Dinner on Thanksgiving Day. **Approved.**
